



## TENURE-TRACK FACULTY POSITION IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

### Position

Tenure-track faculty position in the mathematics/computer science department, starting August 16, 2012.

### Qualifications

Ph.D. preferred; Master's degree in Computer Science considered; expertise in applied mathematics or information technology desirable. Previous collegiate teaching experience desired. Trinity seeks candidates for faculty positions who are professing Christians and committed to excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service. They should support the goals of a strong liberal arts education in the tradition of Reformed Christian higher education and be competent to demonstrate to students a mature articulation of faith and learning. Faculty members are also dedicated to personal involvement with students outside the classroom in advising, social interaction, and informal academic and cultural settings.

### Responsibilities

Primary responsibilities include teaching courses required for the computer science major (e.g., introductory and advanced programming, database systems, data structures and algorithms—see College website for more details). Depending upon expertise, candidates may also be asked to teach courses in applied mathematics (e.g. numerical analysis, statistics) or information technology. In the first year new faculty participate in a year-long formation program beginning on August 13, 2012. The dates of the program next year are August 13-15, 2012.

### Compensation

Rank and salary commensurate with experience. Benefits include health insurance, pension, life insurance, and disability insurance.
