



## HALF-TIME FACULTY POSITION IN MATHEMATICS

### Position

Half-time faculty position as instructor-practitioner in the mathematics department, starting August 16, 2012, pending administrative approval.

### Qualifications

Master's degree in mathematics or mathematics education AND successful K-12 teaching experience required. Ph.D. and/or previous collegiate teaching experience strengthens the application. Trinity seeks candidates for faculty positions who are professing Christians and committed to excellence in teaching, scholarship, and service. They should support the goals of a strong liberal arts education in the tradition of Reformed Christian higher education and be competent to demonstrate to students a mature articulation of faith and learning.

### Responsibilities

Teaching responsibilities will include a total of at least 15 credit hours during the academic year. Other duties include involvement with department meetings and activities.

### Compensation

Rank and salary commensurate with experience at the rate of 50% of a full-time equivalent position.
